Our professional, passionate and fully trained staff provide a secure transport service for children and young people. We have skilled and experienced staff who are able to rapidly build a trusting rapport with children and young people, which we believe to be key to our success.

Our secure transport services also include mentoring the young person throughout the journey, adopting both a nurturing and holistic approach which ensures that each child and young person feels supported, valued and respected.



We provide young people with a comfortable journey with a unique approach at competitive rates as a not-for-profit organisation.

Young people are offered all the essentials including food/drink, magazines, drawing/note pads and blankets to ensure a pleasant experience.

We offer transport for:

Day Trips & Community Engagement

Our aim is to achieve a bright future for all young people and to provide a meaningful development experience with an underlying emphasis on increasing self-esteem. We aim to enhance young people's potential in a supportive environment.

method Our of prevention and intervention with young people involves the use of outdoor and community activities to support positive engagement and facilitate a more effective learning environment for children and young people.



An increased sense of achievement and empowerment has many psychological benefits, particularly for with young people low self-esteem. We believe that constructive engagement in outdoor education provides that sense of achievement necessary to enable positive outcomes.

We offer a flexible package to meet the individual needs of the young people we work with including mentoring.

These include:

- Challenging young people or those who have been excluded from school
- Pupil referral units
- Residential care homes
- Youth justice
- Youth projects





24 Hour Care Service

We provide a safe and comfortable environment, operating a robust on-call system with 24 hour key worker mentors available. We aim to empower young people to make positive changes and help them to overcome any barriers in order to take control of their lives, experience happiness and increase their self-worth.



Each young person has their own agreed support plan specifically designed to offer children and young people short term intensive placements that enable them to make the transition to a residential or foster placement. We work in partnership with local authorities, families and professionals in a team around the child approach. Working with our range of community, special education & support services and external providers, we can offer holistic support for children and young people.

We offer the following individualised support:

- Residential assessments
- Bespoke transport package
- Bespoke 24 hour supervision package
- Mentoring





Parent Support

We offer prevention and early intervention support to provide Carers with the Parents and knowledge and understanding in relation to spotting the signs of risky behaviours and how to safeguard their children.


Risky behaviours include:

- Gang affiliation
- Child sexual exploitation
- Domestic abuse/Violent relationships
- Mental health and/or the risks of substance misuse

Additional sessions include:

- Boundaries and Transition
- Understanding social media
- Admissions and Exclusions
